

Water Memory Game

This Water Memory Game is designed to teach you about water and the water cycle! It's like a traditional memory card game but with a water-themed twist.

Steps

- 1. Cut the cardstock into equal-sized cards (e.g., 10 pairs).
- 2. Draw or stick pictures of water-related items on one side of each pair of cards.
- 3. Lay the cards face down on a table.
- 4. Take turns flipping two cards at a time to find a matching pair.
- 5. Every time a player finds a match, they must describe the item's role in the water cycle.

You will need

- Card or thick paper
- Markers or printed pictures of water-related items (clouds, rivers, rain, tap, glass, ice, etc.)
- Scissors

Helpful tip

Add challenges like making a water-saving suggestion for extra points.

Did you know?

Over 70% of Earth's surface is covered in water, but only 3% is fresh water.
