

## **Rainfall Water Symphony**

This is a super creative activity that combines music and learning about the importance of rainwater!

## Steps


- 1. Fill jars with different levels of water to create musical tones.
- 2. Gently tap the jars with a stick or spoon to make sounds.
- 3. Arrange the jars to play a simple song like "Rain, Rain, Go Away."
- 4. Discuss how rain is a valuable resource for drinking water and irrigation.

## You will need

- Empty jars or bottles of different sizes
- Wooden sticks or spoons
- Water

## Helpful tip

Experiment with adding more or less water to change the tone.
