Rainfall Water Symphony

This is a super creative activity that combines music and learning about the importance of rainwater!

Steps

1. Fill jars with different levels of water to create musical tones.
2. Gently tap the jars with a stick or spoon to make sounds.
3. Arrange the jars to play a simple song like "Rain, Rain, Go Away."
4. Discuss how rain is a valuable resource for drinking water and irrigation.

You will need

- Empty jars or bottles of different sizes
- Wooden sticks or spoons
- Water

Helpful tip

Experiment with adding more or less water to change the tone.
