Duct Tape Design Challenge

Stick with us as we explore one of the war's stickiest inventions! Make your own creation from duct tape, just like engineers and soldiers did during World War Two. From fixing equipment to patching holes, this tough tape became a wartime essential. What will you design with it today?

You'll Need:

- Patterned duct tape
- Scissors
- Card or scrap fabric
- Ruler and pencil

Duct tape helped repair Apollo 13 in space!

Steps:

1. Cut a rectangle of card or fabric to be your base (e.g., wallet or bookmark).
2. Cover one side with duct tape – fold over the edges.
3. Cover the other side and trim the edges neatly.
4. Add pockets or decorations with more duct tape if making a wallet.
5. Test its strength – can it hold coins or notes?
