## Human Radar Game

**Become a radar system in this fun and noisy group activity!** Play a game of beeps and boops to guide your partner through obstacles, just like Britain's early radar towers tracked aircraft in the sky. You'll need to listen carefully and move precisely to avoid being spotted. It's all about communication and timing!

### You'll Need:

- Blindfold
- Large indoor or outdoor space
- Friends or family
- A few simple obstacles (cushions, boxes, cones)

Radar helped win the Battle of Britain by spotting enemy planes from miles away.

### Steps:

1. One person is blindfolded – they are the “radar”.
2. Another is the “operator” and gives directions using sound only:
  - a. “Beep!” = turn left
  - b. “Boop!” = turn right
  - c. “Brrrrp!” = walk forward
3. Place small obstacles around – try to guide the radar through them without touching!
