Bonus: Spot St Sepulchre's church opposite — the City's largest.

## The Golden Boy of Pye Corner

ANSWER: The Fortune of War · 1910

Bonus: Copy the Golden Boy's pose for a photo.

## Henry VIII Gate

ANSWER: 1702

Bonus: Strike a mighty pose like King Henry VIII.

## St Bartholomew's Gatehouse

ANSWER: 1932

Bonus: Spot the crooked timbers — not one is straight.

## St Bartholomew the Great

ANSWER: 1123

Bonus: Find Cloth Fair's crooked old house — it survived the Great Fire.

ANSWER: 1897

ANSWER: 17
